# **MINUTES:**

#### **PRINCIPAL'S REPORT:**

#### Assessments;

- -Kelsey said GSS has finished fall assessments for Grades 8 and 9 Numeracy and Literacy assessments
- -Provincial Grade 10 Literacy assessment is also completed. Numeracy assessment for Grade 10 will take place in January.
- -Literacy Assessments are mandated by the Ministry to be completed 3 times during the school years from Grade 10-12 starting with the first one at the beginning of Grade 10. Students get a couple of opportunities throughout the year to complete the assessments.
- -Numeracy assessments are only done during Grade 10, students have the opportunity to r and retake it up to three times if they are not happy with their scores. Can be taken in the first or second semester. Numeracy is not just Math, there are Literacy components to the assessment.
- -Grade 9 assessments are complete and the teachers are sharing with staff and they are working together with each other to share with District.

## **Student Advisory Committee:**

-1<sup>st</sup> Student advisory committee meeting took place about a week and a half ago. Data was shared with the as well as the PAC and Trustees. Students agreed with the data. There were 15 students who attended the meeting, would like a larger group.

- -Some of the topics discovered were sense of belonging, ownership over learning.
- -Students needed to understand how belonging worked, they like school, people but don't feel that this is their everything. Some of the things that have been impacted due to COVID.
- -They wish to see the Gym open at lunch, this has been discussed with the staff.
- -Will create a survey and send it to all students to get more input.

## Sports/Clubs

Sports are back up and running again.

- -Volleyball is coming to an end. We have many teams for Bantam, Junior and Senior; Boys and Girls who attended various tournaments.
- -Boys had a soccer team that also attended some tournaments.
- -We had few students who also participated in X Country running team with couple Grade 9 students going to Provincials.
- -Basketball is staring this week. We have Bantam, Junior and Senior; Boys and Girls teams practicing regularly.

  - -Constitution is coming in regards to discriminative language. Teaching is going on during suspension and in school suspension.
  - -Kelsey was asked if they used Restorative practices? She said yes these practices are used when the student is feeling regret for their actions.
