#### MINUTES:

- 1. Approval of Agenda / Additions
  - -Navneet made a motion to accept agenda as read. Kelsey seconded and everyone approved.
- 2. Approval of Minutes (Sent via email)

- 3. Principal's report (Kelsey Doolaar)
  - -Kelsey said the community engagement meeting is on Thursday, May 10 and everyone should attend. It was to discuss how the year went. Separate schools went through their 3 year cycle. New cycle is restarting next year.
  - -Grades 8-9 did their Reading and Numeracy assessments.
  - -Grades 8-9 science classes went to learn about the watershed.
  - -There was not good attendance for Kerri Isham's session. May need to do it with students next time in an assembly type session as it was suggested by students.
  - -Spoken word poet came the week before Kerri Isham. He talked about sense of belonging. It was very successful session.

Mike Archibald -Yearbook is 85% complete, last day for submission is May 12th 2023.

- -We will be switching from Jostens to Lifetouch next year. There is the option to get the books in June with an insert in the fall with Grad information. We have sold over 100 books this year. -GRAD is getting fully organized.
- -District Student Advisory Committee (Students) discussed the changes in reporting order.

  Core Competencies might be moving all the way to grade 12. The students were from three secondary schools in the district. The way we currently have been completing the student self-evaluation of core competencies so far in the District has lacked depth and not been meaningful for students in their learning. There has been no directions from the Ministry. How it works is that there are 5 core competencies and students choose 3 and write about these as self

evaluation. Students in the DSAC discussed how we can make the core competencies to work better for the students.

### 4. Awards Ceremony (Mike Archibald)

- -Because of the new reporting order (See attached) it is hard to do the core competency awards for Grades 8-9. This means the awards ceremony will look different next year. Here are a few options;

- -Why can't we combine the two (academic and athletic)
