Bursary Application

Candidates are asked to respond to the following items in a dear and detailed fashion and may attach further information on separate sheets of paper.

Name:

1. FINANCIAL NEED: include such items as family situation, siblings, personal responsibilities, (e.g. car payments, etc.), expected costs (e.g. tuition, textbooks, accommodations, etc.), financial resources (e.g. job, etc.) and any other relevant information. (60 points)

2. POST-SECONDARY PLANS: describe your goals and your preferred post-secondary institution (10 points)

3. SOCIAL AND COMMUNICATION SKILLS/INVOLVEMENT: describe your involvement in community activities (e.g. sports, cadets, guides/scouts, etc.) and school activities (e.g. leadership, drama, sports, music, etc.) (10 points)

4. COURSE ACHIEVEMENT: include a statement of recent marks (10 points)

5. FAMILY BACKGROUND re: ARMED SERVICES: be as specific as possible about any member of your family who may have served in Canada's armed services (e.g. parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles, siblings, etc.) (10 points)
